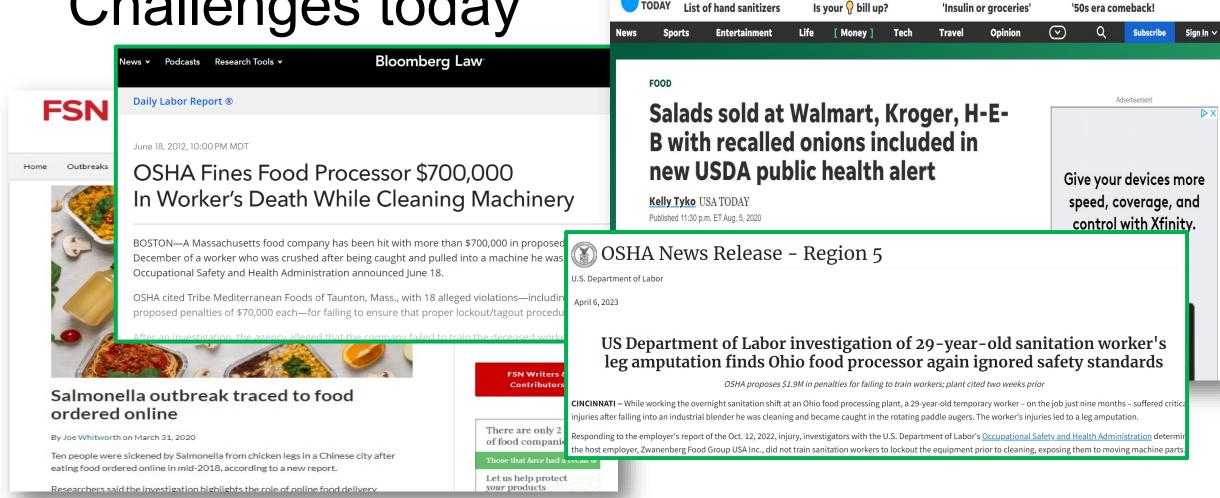

Impact to your employees and business

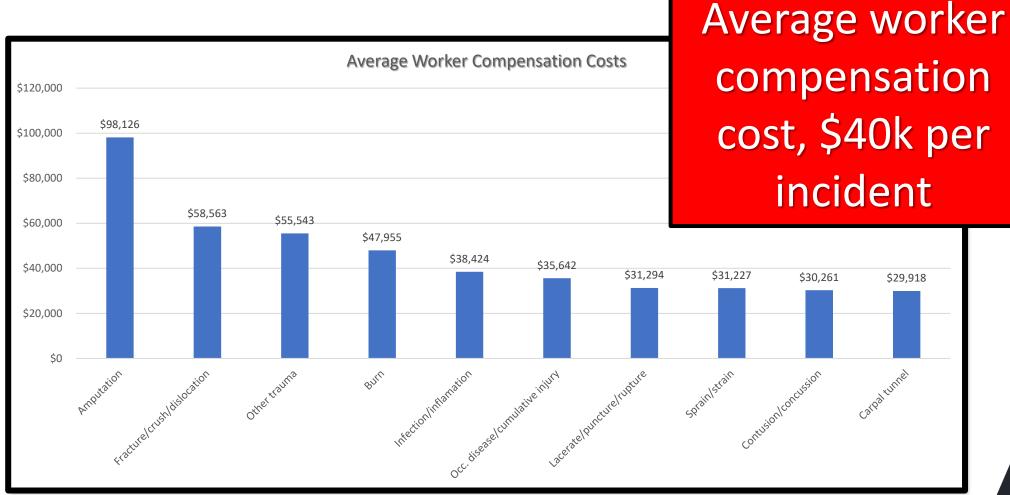


- 7,600+ people die in a work-related accident or illness every day globally...
- Approximately 2.4m workers in the US were injured from a work-related accident...
- The average cost of a single worker compensation for a work-related accident is \$40k per case...
- That's an approximate cost to industry of \$9.6bn...





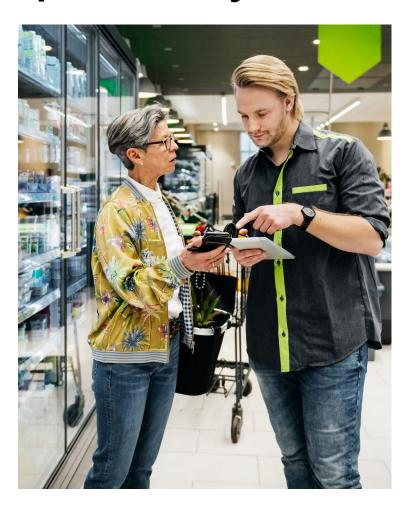
The cost/\$ impact





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Impact to your customers



- 600 million almost 1 in 10 people globally fall ill after eating contaminated food and 420,000 die every year
- US **\$110 billion** is lost each year in productivity and medical expenses resulting from unsafe food...
- Children under 5 years of age carry 40% of the foodborne disease burden, with 125,000 deaths every year...
- CDC estimates that each year roughly 1 in 6
 Americans (or 48 million people) gets sick,
 128,000 are hospitalized, and 3,000 die of
 foodborne diseases...



The challenge

76% of respondents reported at least one symptom of a mental health condition, an increase of 17 percentage points in just two years.

- Auditing





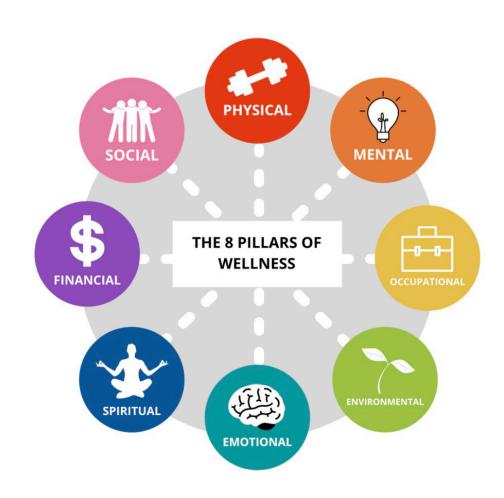

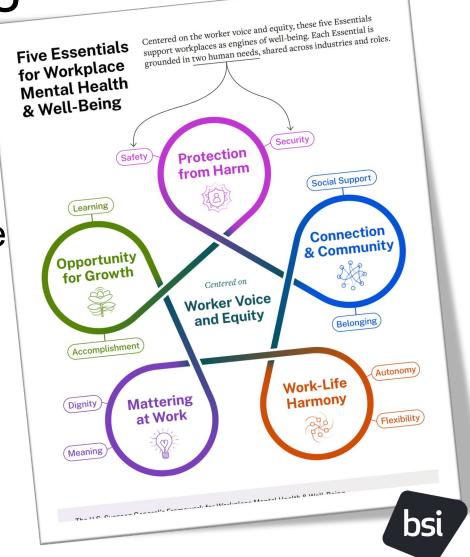
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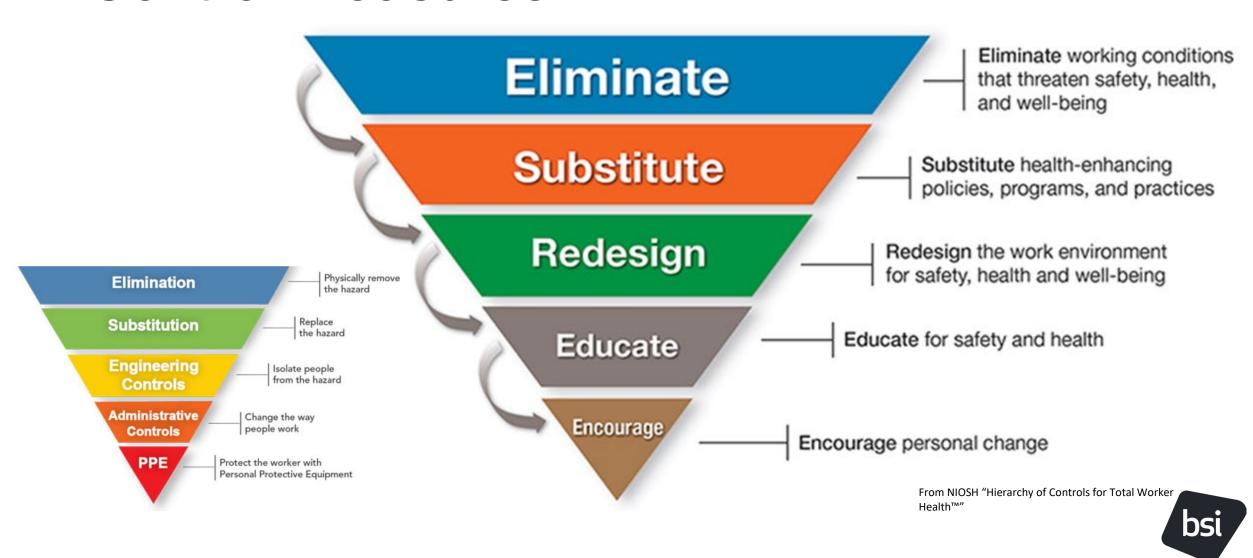

BSI's Prioritizing People Model®

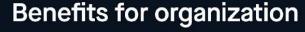
